

FSA Conference January Shout-Out

It's just a true thing about our Conferences, that the value of the friendships, the knowledge shared, the professional growth, and the smiles and memories are **priceless**. It's been a **long 4 years** since we've gathered together with members from all over Florida. It's time!

Here is some information about Conference costs (Oct. 26-28, The Shores in Daytona Beach) to help you plan:

*Registration: **\$75**

*With taxes and resort fees, the rooms will be **\$188 per night**. If the **rooms are shared, divide this amount in half**. This price includes a reduced rate on the resort fee. Most rooms will have a water view either of the ocean or the river.

*Meals will run **\$25 to \$48** per day for our **lunches**. Dinner will be **\$60 x 2 = \$120**. This includes taxes and tips. **The use of all conference rooms for no additional cost is offset by the meal prices**. Food for the event will cost approximately **\$200 for two days**. We will have refrigerators in the rooms so we can bring breakfast items. There are also coffee pots.

*Parking is **\$11.35/day**, including tax. Carpooling will help keep these costs and travel expenses down.

*The **only** other expense will be **entry into the Art, Letters, and Music competitions**. We will have workshops and speakers at meals, and the members will have an opportunity to bring items to sell.


Approximate total for Conference: \$600 for a three-night stay (with shared room), two days of meals, and numerous workshops. This does not include travel expenses or meals on Thursday.
